Orientation to the Graduation Project Oral Presentation

- ▶ This presentation is a reflection of your **abstract plus your tables and figures and a discussion section.**
- ▶ This power point includes the template for your presentation.
- ▶ The presentation should have an average of 10 slides including the introduction, aim, methodology, results, discussion and conclusion.



Orientation to the Graduation Project Oral Presentation

- ▶ All research team members who submitted the research project as their graduation research project should be present during the presentation and should take part in the presentation.
- ▶ The oral presentation will be appraised by a committee of mentors.
- ▶ Once the presentation is done, the appraisal committee members will ask the participating students questions, so be ready, know your research well and know your literature search well.
